Marilyn M. Bui, MD, PhD is a Senior Member in the Department of Anatomic Pathology at Moffitt Cancer Center. Dr. Bui serves as the Scientific Director of Analytic Microscopy Core, the Section Head of Bone and Soft Tissue Pathology, and the President of Medical Staff. She is also a Professor and the Director of Cytopathology Fellowship at the University of South Florida (USF) Morsani College of Medicine.

Provide the best possible patient care is Dr. Bui's number one mission. She also leverages research, education, advocacy and service for better patient care. Her expertise includes bone and soft tissue pathology, cytopathology and digital pathology.

She has published over 170 peer-reviewed articles, 15 book chapters and 2 books including *Atlas of Soft Tissue and Bone Pathology* by Demos Medical and *The Healing Art of Pathology* by College of American Pathologist (CAP) Press. She has received national and institutional awards in cancer research, education and service.

As a pathology leader, Dr. Bui is a member of the National Comprehensive Cancer Network (NCCN) Soft Tissue Sarcoma Panel, the American Society of Cytopathology Foundation board and the Florida Society of Pathologists board. She will be the President of the Digital Pathology Association in 2019. She is the Chair of the CAP Publications Committee and the Vice Chair of the Digital Pathology Committee. Dr. Bui also chairs the CAP Quantitative Image Analysis (QIA) of HER2 Immunohistochemistry (IHC) for Breast Cancer expert panel which developed an evidence-based guideline to improve accuracy and reproducibility of the interpretation of HER2 IHC by QIA. Digital pathology has significantly enhanced Dr. Bui's ability in delivering quality patient care through cancer diagnosis, research and education. *The Pathologist* magazine named Dr. Bui to its 2015 & 2018 Power List.
