



## FMA Delegate Expectations

The FMA House of Delegates is the legislative and business body of the Florida Medical Association. Its members are the officers of the FMA, the elected members of the Board of Governors, and the delegates officially elected by the component societies, specialty societies, Specialty Society Section, Young Physicians Section, Medical Student Section, Resident & Fellow Section and the FMA Alliance. The House meets annually as determined by the FMA Board of Governors. The number of delegates the FSP has is based on the size of its membership. Historically the FSP has been allotted 3 seats.

### **Expectations:**

- Attend the FMA House of Delegates Meeting as a delegate for the FSP. This meeting historically has been in Orlando, Florida and is a three-day meeting taking place on a weekend.
- Actively participate in the House of Delegates Meeting and voting procedures
- Be an active advocate for FSP by developing relationships with other delegates, participating in specialty sessions, discussions, and social events
- Prepare a report to the Board and membership on the meeting, highlighting issues of special concern for pathologists
