Dr Mehrdad Nadji is a Diplomate of the American Board of Pathology in Anatomic and Clinical Pathology and holds the Specialty Certificate in Cytopathology. During his tenure at the University of Miami, Dr. Nadji has served as the Director of Immunohistochemistry, Director of Cytopathology, Director of Pathology Outreach Specialty Services, Director of Anatomic Pathology and in 2007-2008 as the Interim Chairman of Department of Pathology and Chief of Laboratory Services at Jackson Memorial Hospital.

He also had established for the first time the Diagnostic Immunohistochemistry Laboratory, Diagnostic Aspiration Cytology Services, Pathology Consultation Services and the Research Molecular Pathology Laboratory. He has trained innumerable pathology residents and fellows many of whom are, or have been, faculty members at the UM and other academic institutions, or serve as practicing pathologists in regional, national and international laboratories. Dr. Nadji's areas of research interest include diagnostic and predictor biomolecular markers of human solid tumors. He has authored or coauthored more than 200 peer-reviewed scientific papers and 15 books, chapters and monographs. He has served on the Editorial Boards of 11 Pathology and Cancer journals. He has represented the University of Miami as an invited speaker in more than 300 national and international scientific meetings.
