

Gregory Y. Lauwers, M.D.

Dr. Gregory Y. Lauwers is a Senior Member at the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and Research Institute and Professor of Pathology at the Morsani College of Medicine at the University of South Florida. His research has focused on oncologic surgical pathology of the gastrointestinal tract. Dr. Lauwers has published over 300 peer-reviewed articles, editorials, reviews, and book chapters, and is coauthor of several textbooks, including the 5th edition of *Morson and Dawson's Gastrointestinal Pathology* and *Advances in Surgical Pathology: Gastric Cancer*. Dr. Lauwers serves on the editorial boards of several journals, and he is Deputy Editor-in-Chief of the *Archives of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine*. He served on the Editorial and Consensus Working Group for the WHO Classification of Tumours Series, 4th Ed., and contributed to the *WHO Classification of Tumours of the Digestive System* (2010). Dr. Lauwers is also Clinical Professor, University of Western Australia; and Adjunct Professor, Pusan National University School of Medicine.
